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About this guide

This guide lists the sources behind the American Acorns family history: the records reviewed for the site's labelled findings, the printed works used in its profiles and stories, and the online databases that the imported family tree cites. It is a source guide, not a narrative family history, and it does not claim that the research is complete.

Public edition. It lists only what the public website shows. People who may be living, or whose living status is uncertain, are not named, and family-only notes and sources are left out. Links lead to the relevant pages of americanacorns.com and to each source's own provider where it is online.

How the citations are written. Published works follow Chicago notes-and-bibliography conventions.¹ For records, the bibliography names the source as a whole, such as a register, a court's case files or a census, and the numbered record-level notes identify the specific entry, image or page that was consulted, the provider through which it was seen, and whether an original image, an index or a transcription was used, following the approach of *Evidence Explained*.² A database entry is never presented as an original record that was inspected. Details the research did not record are left out or marked as not recorded; none are supplied by guesswork.

What counts as a source here. The bibliography lists sources that were actually consulted. Archival leads that were identified but not obtained are not listed. The databases the imported tree cites appear in their own section because they were not re-examined for this guide.

Dates. "Last compiled on" is the date this edition was produced. The family data snapshot is the date of the family tree export that the site shows, and the research revision identifies the reviewed research incorporated into it; each can change independently.

Evidence labels and source types

Each fact and each parent–child or partner relationship on the site carries one of three labels.³ A label rates that one statement, never a whole person, family or source.

Confirmed

Evidence directly supports the statement, the person or relationship is confidently identified, and no material contradiction remains.

Likely

The evidence makes a coherent case, but the identification or relationship is indirect, or a material gap remains.

Unconfirmed

There is not enough evidence for the statement, or records conflict too much for a stronger label. Unconfirmed does not mean disproved. Entries from the imported family tree that nobody has reviewed are Unconfirmed.

Confidence is not the same as source type

A label describes how well a specific statement is supported; the kind of source describes what was consulted. An original register image can leave a statement only Likely if the identification is indirect, and several independent index entries can together support a Confirmed statement. The record-level notes therefore say for each source how it was consulted: an image of the original, an index or transcription, a printed copy, a gravestone photograph, a memorial page or a family account. Printed town vital records are copies of the original town books, which were not viewed. A family tradition is marked as such on the site: that a tradition was printed can be Confirmed while the events it describes remain Unconfirmed.

In the record-level notes, “Supports” and “Contradicts” list the findings on the site that each source bears on, with the label each finding now carries.
